Almost 100% attendance in primary schools on first day back

Primary schools in Jersey recorded a 93% attendance rate yesterday for the first day back to school for many students following the closures. Nearly all primary schools in Jersey recorded extremely high attendance yesterday, with rates ranging from 70% to 100%. Secondary schools who welcomed back Year 10 students for face-to-face learning also had a high attendance rate of 70 to 90% of those expected to attend.
