Wednesday Night Update

So, a big day in the States Assembly today and the news is in the main, the Amendments brought by the Scrutiny Liaison Committee first:

The States Assembly has voted to **REJECT** the proposal to amend the Safer Travel Policy start date to 10th July 2020.

15 FOR vs 29 AGAINST - 1 ABSTENTION

The States Assembly has voted to **REJECT** the amendment to the Safer Travel Period policy which makes changes to self-isolation requirements and onward travel provisions.

18 FOR vs 29 AGAINST

The States Assembly has voted to **REJECT** the amendment that all future changes to the Safer Travel Period policy must be lodged at least 1 week before debate.

22 FOR vs 26 AGAINST

The States Assembly has voted to **ADOPT** the amendment to the Safer Travel Period policy relating to the provision of details such as countries designated safe for travel, R numbers, test results and more.

41 FOR vs 5 AGAINST

At 5:30pm there was a proposition to adjourn until tomorrow – but was rejected.

So onward they went to the main proposition

The Safer Travel Period P.84 was adopted ... pour 34 and 10 contre

Co-funding for June is now open with new guidance notes.
