The total number of visitors to St Helier, King Street for the last 52 weeks is 5,608,004 which is 15.7% down on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 3,283,049 which is 5.4% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to St Helier, King Street in week commencing 9 August 2021 was 133,322.

The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Monday 9 August 2021 with footfall of 2,862.


Footfall by week Weather






Footfall by day




Footfall by hour


