The total number of visitors to St Helier, King Street for the last 52 weeks is 5,065,224 which is 44.3% down on the previous year.

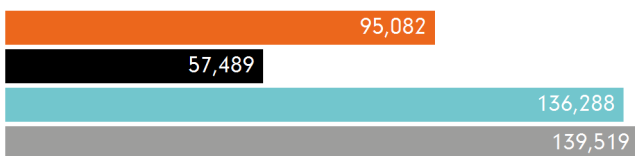
The total number of visitors for the year to date is 310,111 which is 54.7% down on the previous year.

Footfall by week

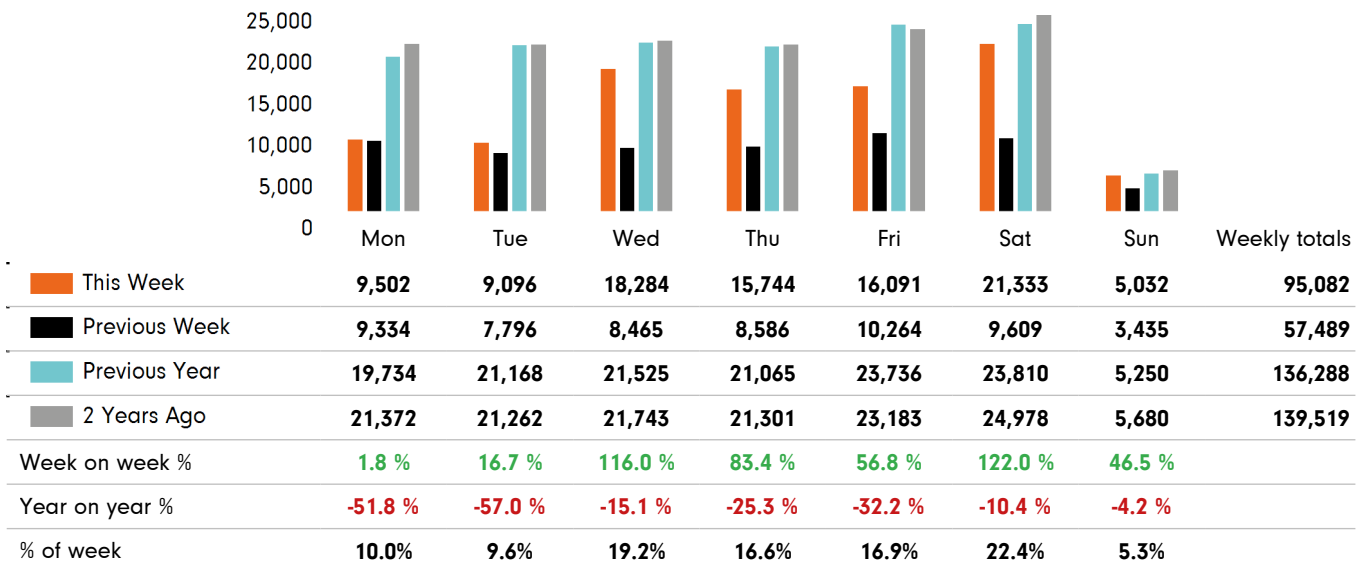

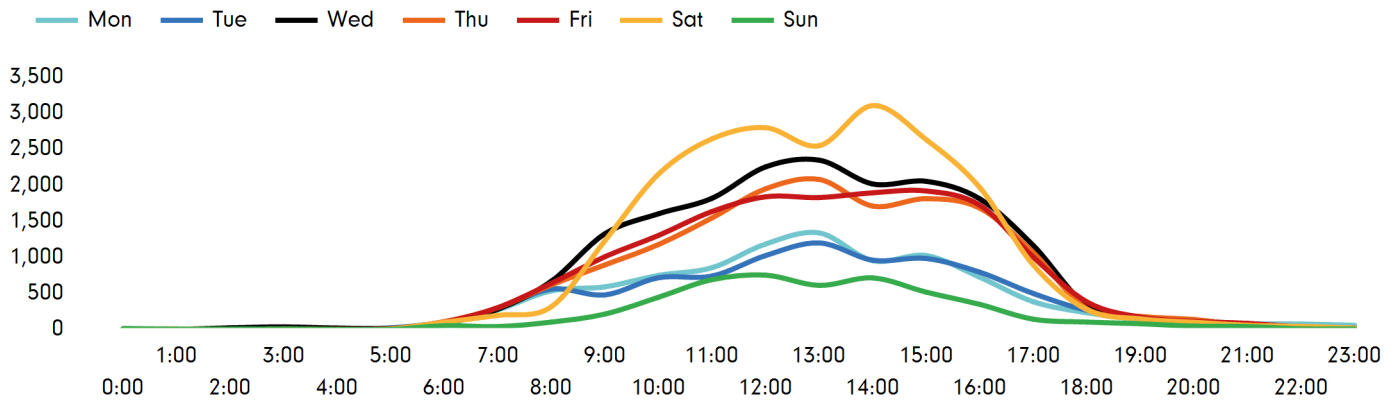

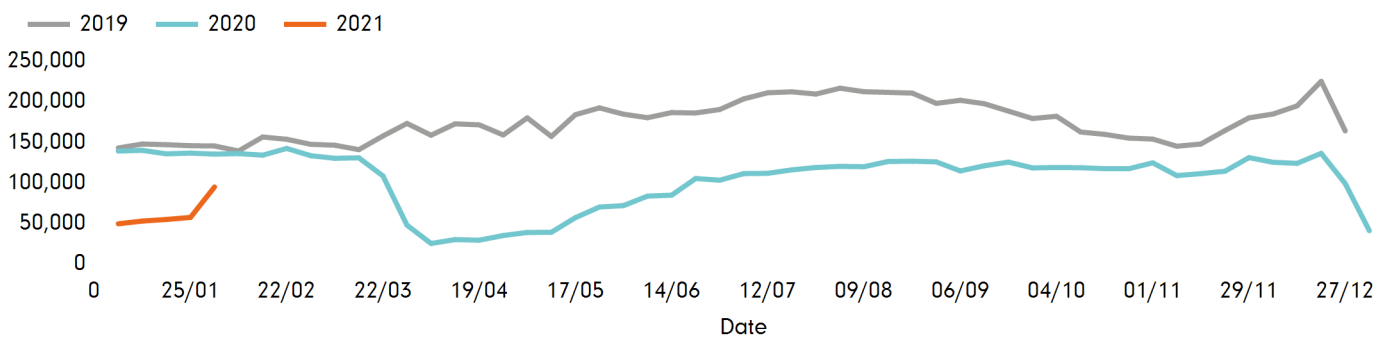
Footfall by day



Footfall by hour

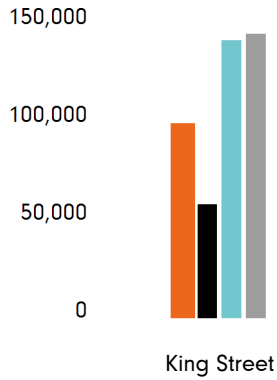


Footfall by week
